

JESUS TEACHES ABOUT GOOD PLANTS AND WEEDS

[The region of Galilee] — Jesus liked to use picture stories, or “parables” to teach people about God’s kingdom. Once he used a picture story about a farmer who wanted to grow a good crop. The farmer got his field ready and then bought some good seed. He planted carefully. He covered all the seed and waited for the rain and sun to make it grow. But when the crops came up, there were weeds growing right next to the plants.

The farmer’s helper said, “We couldn’t have put all those weeds in there. Where did they come from?” The farmer said, “Somebody who doesn’t like me did this.” When the farmer’s helper said, “Let’s pull the weeds out!” the farmer said, “No, let them grow until we can harvest everything. We may pull out the good crop if we pull the weeds out now.”

Jesus said the good crop is like God’s family. And the weeds are like the people who do not love God. Some day God will invite all the people who love him to live with him.
